STATE OF OHIO, MERCER COUNTY, SS:

I, Patrolman Zac Nelson, do hereby state that I am employed at the Celina Police Department. The following did occur:

On August 2, 2025, at approximately 10:31 P.M, I saw a male riding a bicycle on Beaver Street, in the City of Celina. I watched as the male continued travelling Westbound. He proceeded to travel through private property, and into the 500 Block of Sycamore Street. It was also dark, and the bicycle didn't have a rear reflector. I initiated a traffic stop and recognized the driver as William Fetters, also known as Bill.

I had Bill step off the bicycle, and I patted him down for weapons. While doing so, I heard and felt the crinkle of a plastic baggie and could feel a hard rock-like substance inside. This was on the right-side pocket near his belt line. From my training and experience, I know this is a common way to transport illegal narcotics. I removed the object from the coin pocket of the pants and saw that it was a baggie with a clear crystal-like rock that I recognize as being methamphetamine. I placed Fetters under arrest and read him his Miranda warning. Fetters invoked his rights and refused to talk to me. I transported him to the Mercer County Detention Facility where he was booked in.

I later field tested the contents of the baggie, and it tested positive for methamphetamine. The contents weighed approximately two grams.
