
**Date of Offense**              On or about August 25, 2025

**AFFIDAVIT ON COMPLAINT**  
**(O.R.C. 2935.09)**

STATE OF OHIO, MERCER COUNTY, SS:

I, William Miller, do hereby state that I am employed at the Rockford Police Department.  
The following did occur:

On August 25, 2025, I was on patrol when off-duty Rockford Police Chief, Brian Stetler called me and told me that he had taken a phone call from a citizen reporting a crime. Stetler told me that Victim # 1 of 209 North Main Street, Rockford, Ohio reported that an unknown male walked into his home, uninvited. I spoke with Victim # 1 via three way calling. Victim # 1 said that a male walked into the side door to his home. He and his wife, Victim # 2, confronted the male and told him to leave. The male left, only to return a second time. He came into the home and again, Victims # 1 and # 2 told him to leave. The male left walking Southbound on North Main Street. He gave a description of the male as wearing blue jeans and had a red beard.

I found a male walking in the area of Main and Second Streets in Rockford, that matched the description given by Victim # 1. I contacted this male and identified him as Matthew J. Daisy, date of birth of 1/18/1980. I asked Daisy about walking into someone's home, and he denied any knowledge of that. I asked him if he would ride with me, back to the Victim's home. Daisy agreed. I transported him back to 209 North Main Street. Victim # 1 looked at Daisy and said that he was positive that this was the same man that walked into his home, left, and then reentered.

Daisy was transported to the Mercer County Detention Facility.
